POSITION INFORMATION:

The Patrol Leader is elected by his patrol and he represents them at the Patrol Leaders Council.

Age Requirement: None Term: 6 months

Reports to: SPL & ASM Rank: Must be 1st Class or higher (or have Scoutmaster permission)

Training: You must attend Junior Leader Training even if you've attended in the past.

REQUIREMENTS:

Effort: You are expected to give your BEST effort in all that you do as Patrol Leader.

Lead by Example: Live by the Scout Oath and Law. Demonstrate Scout Spirit. Properly wear the Scout uniform at all appropriate times. Show enthusiasm in all that you do.

Attendance: Set the example by being on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the SPL, your APL and ASM if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. The APL must be informed and updated with the information needed to cover for you if you are not available.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Plan and lead your patrol in all meetings and activities
- Prepare your patrol to take part in all troop activities. Keep patrol members informed as necessary.
- Assign patrol members tasks and help them succeed
- Represent your patrol at all patrol leader's council meetings and at the annual planning conference
- Appoint an Assistant Patrol Leader who will function as PL in your absence.
- Help any members of your Patrol with advancement through First Class, either by reaching the required skills or by setting up situations for meeting the requirements.
