POSITION INFORMATION:

Various Junior Leader positions are selected by the SPL and Patrol Leaders to support the troop. These positions serve a variety of functions and require many different skills – there's a job that every Scout in the Troop can fill.

REQUIREMENTS:

Effort: You are expected to give your BEST effort at whatever position you accept.

Lead by Example: Live by the Scout Oath and Law. Demonstrate Scout Spirit. Properly wear the Scout uniform at all appropriate times. Show enthusiasm in all that you do.

Attendance: Set the example by being on-time for meetings and activities. You must notify your supervising leader if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. Others must be informed and updated with the information needed to cover for you if you are not available.

Training: You will need to attend Junior Leader Training (even if you have attended before!).
