

SENIOR PATROL LEADER



POSITION INFORMATION:

The Senior Patrol Leader is elected to represent the Scouts as the top junior leader in the troop.

Term: 6 months

Age requirement: None

Reports to: Scoutmaster

Rank: Must be 1st Class or higher

Training: You must attend Junior Leader Training even if you've attend in the past.

REQUIREMENTS:

Effort: You are expected to give your BEST effort.

Uniform: Set the examples by wearing the full uniform with all badges in correct positions, shirt tail tucked in, etc.

Attendance: Set the example by being on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the Scoutmaster and your ASPL if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. The ASPL must be informed and updated with the information needed to cover for you if you are not available.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- * Preside at all troop meeting, events & activities from beginning to end
- * Chair the patrol leaders council
- * Appoints boy leaders with the counsel and consent of the Scoutmaster
- * Oversees all positions in the Troop
- * Assign duties and responsibilities to other junior leaders
- * Set a good example
- * Wear the Scout uniform correctly
