Who should attend: Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Webelos Leaders, Venturing Leaders, Varsity Leaders, anyone associated with the outdoor program

Elements of the training include:

Rank requirement skills from Tenderfoot thru 1st Class including:

Campsite & Firesite Selection

Plant ID, Animal ID, Packing & Hiking,

Map & Compass, Ropes & Knots, Woods Tools

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (ITOLS) will be held in conjunction with the Wapiti District Camporee. If you are attending with a Camporee troop, you should sleep and eat with that troop.

If you are attending without a host troop, you should plan on bringing your own sleeping accommodations and food, as meals will not be provided as part of the course.

All participants are expected to camp overnight Friday evening as part of the course. Classes will start Saturday morning at 10:00AM after the opening flag ceremony and will end at 5:00PM
