- ### The 2011 Wauna La-Mon'tay Lodge Service Project
- Where:** Camp Lewis
- What:** For our 2011 annual Lodge service project, we're building our second day camp obstacle course, this time at Camp Lewis. The obstacle course will have many different physically challenging elements including: climbing walls, log walks, tunnels, and hanging bridges.
- When:** Service workdays are held on Saturday's from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM. For those interesting in coming down the night before for some fellowship (and getting an early start Saturday), accommodations will be available at Camp Lewis. Currently the workdays are scheduled on:
- ◆ February 5th
  - ◆ February 26th
  - ◆ March 26th
  - ◆ April 23rd

**What to Bring:** Wear work clothes and bring gloves, rain gear, water bottle, and lots of energy. We can also typically use shovels, rakes and wheel barrows.

If coming down Friday night, bring sleeping bag and toiletries. Plan on eating dinner before you arrive and bringing your own breakfast. Lunch provided at no cost to all on Saturday.

**Cost:** No charge (lunch provided). Pre-registration is not required, although please let Chris Derbyshire if you are planning on coming on Friday night so he can reserve you a campsite.
